The words of Archbishop Eamon Martin at the unveiling of the statue of St Oliver Plunkett: *"My hope is that when people feel their faith is being tested or growing weak, they will visit St Oliver's shrine here in the Cathedral and find strength and healing. I want people to come here to experience God's love and closeness when life is getting them down, and they are losing hope - whether it be in their relationships or in their chosen vocation. I invite people to visit St Oliver's shrine when they are afraid of what lies ahead for them, or when they are concerned about the direction which their family members are taking in life. May all who come here look up at the statue of St Oliver and gain serenity, courage, wisdom and hope for themselves and for others. Remember, on the day of St Oliver's canonisation, Pope Paul VI said: 'The message of Oliver Plunkett offers hope that is greater than the present life; it shows a love that is stronger than death.'"*
