When we cannot attend Mass, we can still make an Act of Spiritual Communion, in which we express our faith in Christ and in His Presence in the Eucharist, and ask him to unite Himself with us. Here is an Act of Spiritual Communion:

My Jesus,

I believe that you are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love you above all things, and I desire to receive you into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive you sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart.

I embrace you as if you were already there and unite myself wholly to you. Never permit me to be separated from you.

Amen.

Attendance at funeral Masses should be limited to close relatives and must not exceed 100 attendees within the church building. Therefore all funerals for the foreseeable future will be PRIVATE family celebrations.

Similarly, all weddings must not exceed 100 people.

It is recommended that for the celebration of Baptisms, only parents and godparents attend.

Again, people can participate in these celebrations via the church webcam.

Our three churches will remain open to allow people the opportunity to have time for quiet prayer and reflection.
