Daily Mass **Monday** **8.00pm** **Tuesday - Saturday** **10.00am**

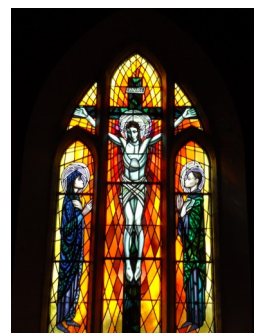

Our Parish Office is closed, however telephone & emails will still be dealt with and Anniversary Masses and Special Intentions can still be booked in the usual way.

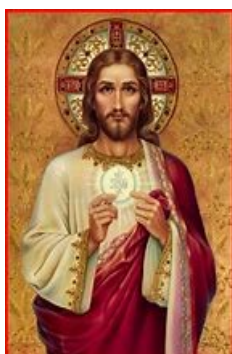
