

First Confession

Our Primary 4 children had been preparing to celebrate First Confession on 25th March, but due to the COVID-19 restrictions it had to be postponed.

So it is that the first public celebration in our parish is for our P.4 children.

First Confession will now be celebrated on Tuesday 30th June at 7.00pm and 7.45pm in Church of the Assumption, Tullyallen.

First Holy Communion will be celebrated on Saturday 15th August at 11.00am & 1.00pm In Tullyallen.

(Please Note: the seating capacity of our church is 100)

Return to the Public Celebration of Mass and the Sacraments

We now begin the gradual process of reopening our churches for public Mass. Our Masses will be celebrated in a very different atmosphere. With the help of our Parish Pastoral Council, a Welcoming Ministry has been formed to assist you with the use of the hand sanitisers provided, to guide you to the limited seating and to help with a one way system for entering and leaving the church. It is very important that you feel comfortable and at ease with these new regulations.

We will open The Church of the Assumption, Tullyallen for public Mass on Thursday 2nd July at 10.00am. The maximum capacity for this church is 100 people.

From then on, Public Mass will be celebrated on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays at 7.30pm in Tullyallen, beginning on Monday 6th July. There will be no Mass on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays to accommodate the cleaning and sanitising of the church after each Mass. At the moment there will be no public Mass on Sundays as the Sunday Mass might attract a larger crowd and therefore compromise the health and safety of everyone attending.

The reason for three evening Masses is to accommodate as many families as possible. Could people agree to go to one evening Mass each week and make that Mass their 'Sunday Mass'?

We do not want to rush. This is a gradual process. Anyone still shielding should not attend Mass at this time. The health and safety of everyone is of paramount importance. These new arrangements will be reviewed after a month.

The collection baskets will be placed on tables at the back of the church and also at the exit porch. Baskets should not be passed through the seats. Please leave your envelope in the basket, either as you enter or when you leave.
