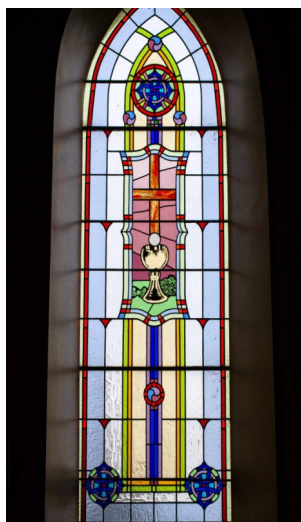

Parish Envelopes:

Many people have been asking about their Parish Envelope and how best to make a contribution towards the parish. We are in extremely challenging times at the moment, but for those who wish to, or can make a contribution, you can put your envelopes in the POST box beside the door of the Parochial House any day between 2-6pm or you can arrange to set up a Standing Order.

Return to the Public Celebration of Mass and the Sacraments

Beginning on Sunday 16th August public Mass will be celebrated every Sunday at 11.00am in Tullyallen.

There are three evening Masses each week to accommodate as many families as possible. Could people agree to go to one evening Mass each week and make that Mass their 'Sunday Mass'?

We do not want to rush. This is a gradual process. The health and safety of everyone is of paramount importance. These new arrangements will be reviewed at the end of August.

The collection baskets will be placed on tables at the back of the church and also at the exit porch. Baskets should not be passed through the seats. Please leave your envelope in the basket, either as you enter or when you leave. Envelopes can also be left at the Parochial House.

Baptism

Anyone wishing to book a Baptism please contact the Parish Office. Baptisms are arranged by appointment only and three weeks notice must be given. **From September they will be held on the second and fourth weekend of every month.**

Parents, godparents, grandparents and child's siblings should only attend.

First Holy Communion

Our Primary 4 girls and boys will receive their First Holy Communion next Saturday 15th August, the feast day of the Assumption of Our Lady, at 11.00am & 1.00pm in Tullyallen.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions the seating capacity in our church is limited to 100 people.

We ask that only the First Communicant, parents and siblings attend.

Musicians and a cantor will provide the music on First Holy Communion Day. The gallery will therefore not be available.
