Funeral Masses are restricted to a maximum of 25 people. Face masks/coverings should be worn inside the church. Music should be by a soloist/cantor only. When a funeral occurs the 10.00am Mass will be cancelled. Any Mass intention will be included in the funeral Mass.

### Baptism

Anyone wishing to book a Baptism please contact the Parish Office. Baptisms are arranged by appointment only and three weeks notice must be given. From September they will be held on the second and fourth weekend of every month. Parents, godparents, grandparents and child's siblings should only attend.


#### November Mass for the Deceased
