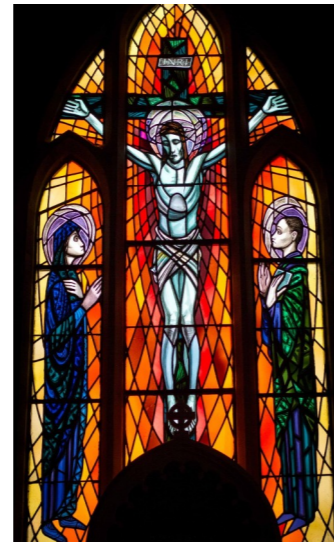

At this time we are unable to reopen Aughnagar for Sunday morning Mass. Fridays will be reserved for Month Minds and First Anniversaries. These may be celebrated in any of the three churches. We will have another review at the end of October.

Face Coverings

Thank you for continuing to ensure that our celebration of Mass and other Liturgies remain safe places for all who join us. It has been acknowledged that the wearing of face masks, in conjunction with hand washing and social distancing etc are likely to reduce the spread of Coronavirus, thus helping to protect others and ourselves. While the government has not formally made it mandatory, all Church leaders strongly recommend that people attending church should wear face coverings, apart from those people considered exempt and children under the age of 13

Diocesan Faith Awards

The Pope John Paul II Award enables young people in the Archdiocese of Armagh to take an active part in the life of their Church, in the life of their community and society, and also become more aware of the teaching and role of the Catholic Church in the world.

The Archdiocese of Armagh was unable to hold the annual Diocesan Faith Award Celebration in St Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh back in March, due to the outbreak of Covid-19, therefore parishes are now assisting with the distribution of the Awards.
