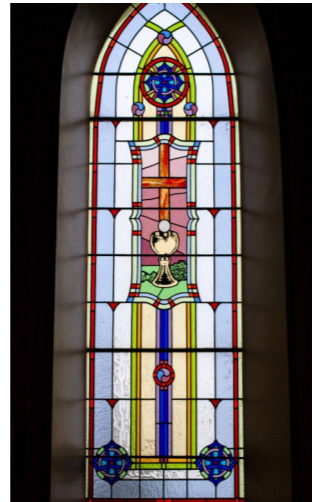

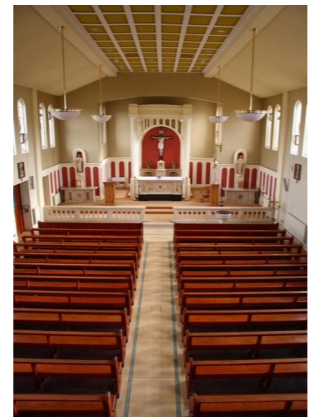

**Returning to the New Normal in St Patrick's Aughnagar and St Joseph's Ackinduff - Phase 3**

After a review meeting with the Pastoral Council we are delighted to announce that St Patrick's Aughnagar will reopen for Public Mass on Sunday mornings. Our new Mass schedule is as follows:

**Fridays will be reserved for Month Minds and First Anniversaries. These may be celebrated in any of the three churches. We will have another review at the end of November.**

**Hands, Face, Space**

As we move into the Winter months it has become increasingly important that we adhere to social distancing, sanitising of hands and wearing of face coverings.

Thank you for continuing to ensure that our celebration of Mass and other Liturgies remain safe places for all who join us. Everyone attending church should wear face coverings, apart from those people considered exempt and children under the age of 13. Please be sure to sanitise your hands on entering and exiting the church.

**For the reception of Holy Communion, please allow the ushers/helpers to direct you from your seat, row by row.**

**This should mean that receiving Holy Communion is more respectful, orderly and safe.**

**In order to do this we need more help. I am asking for people to volunteer for this ministry. Please contact myself or any member of the Pastoral Council as soon as possible.**

**Regulations re Funerals, Months Mind & First Anniversary Masses during the Covid-19**

**Pandemic** In line with current guidelines, Social Distancing is to be observed at all times. Wakes/Funerals/Burials are private to close family members and friends. Funeral Masses are restricted to a maximum of 25 people. Face masks/coverings should be worn inside the church. Music should be by a soloist/cantor only. When a funeral occurs the 10.00am Mass will be cancelled. Any Mass intention will be included in the funeral Mass.

**Baptism**

Anyone wishing to book a Baptism please contact the Parish Office. Baptisms are arranged by appointment only and three weeks notice must be given.

**They will be held on the second and fourth weekend of every month. Parents, godparents, grandparents and child's siblings should only attend.**

**November Mass for the Deceased**

This year the month of November, in which we traditionally remember the dead and pray for the bereaved, will be particularly poignant. We are especially mindful of those grieving families who, because of restrictions, have been unable to experience the customary spiritual and community supports which are so



much a part of our Irish tradition. The third of our special Masses to remember our dead will be celebrated on **Tuesday 24th November in Aughnagar at 7.30pm** The names of all those who have died in the last twelve months will be called out and a candle lit in their memory. Dead lists and envelopes are available in our three churches. Please return completed lists to the church collection boxes or the Parochial House.
