Triduum of Prayer to St Joseph

To mark the 150th anniversary of the declaration of St Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church, Pope Francis has proclaimed this year as a Year of St Joseph. A special Triduum of Prayer to St Joseph will be celebrated throughout the diocese on 12th, 13th & 14 October.

Our parish will celebrate this Triduum of Prayer as follows:

Tuesday 12th 10.00am Mass Aughnagar

St Joseph, a family man and protector of all families, a man who models for us the family's call to holiness. We invite families to join on this day, to ask St Joseph to intercede for all our homes and families.

Wednesday 13th 10.00am Mass Tullyallen

St Joseph, a worker and the patron of all craftspeople and workers. He laboured for God and we too are called to labour in love. We invite all workers and those retired to join on this day for a special blessing of our hands.

Thursday 14th Triduum concludes with Devotions at 7.30pm in St Joseph's Ackinduff.

St Joseph, the dreamer, an example for everyone and especially our young whom Jesus teaches never to lose the ability to dream, to take risks and to take on difficult tasks. We invite all who have dreams to join and especially young people and expectant mothers who have dreams for their child and their children.

Local Launch of the Synodal Pathway – October 17th

This weekend in Rome Pope Francis will launch a new time of reflection for the whole Church based on the theme "For a synodal Church: communion, participation, mission". The local launch of this process will take place in every diocese and parish around the world on Sunday next, October 17th. Over the next four months the Church worldwide will be consulting all its members on their experience of the decision-making processes within the Church and how we are working together to achieve our mission. This will be done by means of questionnaires, online and in person discussion, and through social media.

World Mission Sunday - 24th October

Next weekend we celebrate World Mission Sunday. We are invited to remember the needs of the universal Church in our prayer, to pray for missionaries and an increase in missionary vocations, and to reach out with greater love, generosity and courage to those on the peripheries of our family, our church, our society and our world today.
