

# Local Launch of the Synodal Pathway – October 17<sup>th</sup>

Last Sunday Pope Francis launched the period of preparation and consultation leading up to the synod in 2023 with the theme "For a synodal Church: communion, participation, mission". The local launch of this process will take place in every diocese and parish around the world this Sunday October 17<sup>th</sup>. Over the next four months the Church worldwide will be consulting all its members on their experience of the decision-making processes within the Church and how we are working together to achieve our mission. This will be done by means of questionnaires, online and in person discussion, and through social media.


