Synodal Pathway

The diocesan phase of the preparation for the 2023 Synod will involve the largest consultation with the lay faithful ever to take place and will examine what life is like in the Church at this moment in time. The Diocesan Pastoral Team has decided to circulate four questions for consultation in the Archdiocese of Armagh:

- 1. What memory or experience of the Catholic Church do you value or cherish most in your life?**
- 2. How can our Church be a welcoming and inclusive community?**
- 3. How can we be listened to more effectively and encouraged to participate in decision-making processes in the Church?**
- 4. What inspires you in the life of your Parish Community to bring the love of Christ into the world. What discourages you?**

Question sheets are available in each of our churches. Your responses should be anonymous and can be returned to Ara Coeli Armagh by the 31st January.

Week of Witness

'Week of Witness' will take place from this Sunday 21st to Saturday 27th November. During this week we will remember all who have given great witness to their faith in the past and those who continue to give witness today and all who will continue to give great witness in the future. On Wednesday 24th November Archbishop Eamon Martin will celebrate a special Liturgy in St Patrick's Cathedral, Armagh at 7.30pm.

As part of the Liturgy, Archbishop Eamon will speak with two young people who give great witness to their faith today. People are invited to wear something red on the evening. After the Liturgy, Archbishop Eamon will launch a new book in the Synod Hall titled "*In His Master's Footsteps—The Way of the Cross in the Company of St Oliver Plunkett, Archbishop and Martyr*" edited by Canon Benedict Fee. All are welcome to join us on the evening.
