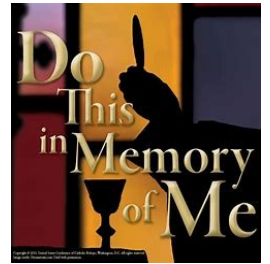
Parish Mission Statement
