Peace Light from Bethlehem

In its 36th year, the Peace light from Bethlehem campaign was originally organised by the Austrian Broadcasting Company and was part of a large charitable relief mission for children in need in Austria and abroad. Since 1986 there has been a great deal of co-operation between Scouts and Guides in many countries which has allowed the light to travel throughout Europe. Each year a child from Upper Austria kindles a flame from the "Eternal Flame" from the Nativity Grotto in Bethlehem. The light is then distributed to delegations from across Europe who take it back with a message of peace to their own countries. The 10th Tyrone Killeeshil Scouts will bring the Peace Light of Bethlehem to the Vigil Mass in Ackinduff at 7.00pm this Saturday 17th December.
