Be - Longing: Praying for Unity Amidst Injustice

Here in Ireland this year marks two important anniversaries of key events in the journey towards Christian Unity. This year is the centenary of the formation of the Irish Council of Churches and it also marks the 50th anniversary of the Ballymascanlon Meetings between the Catholic Church and other Christian Churches on the island of Ireland in 1973, a structure that is now the Irish Inter-Church Meeting. A special Service marking both of these anniversaries will take place on Sunday 22nd January at 3.30pm in St Anne's Cathedral, Belfast.

Sectarianism is still, sadly, a major problem in communities and political life in the north while the growth of racism is increasingly evident across the island. The current cost of living crisis and the effects of the war in Ukraine add to the turmoil. We pray that our hearts will be open to see and hear the many ways in which racism continues to destroy lives, and to discern the steps we can take as individuals and communities to heal the hurts and build a better future for everyone.
