Friday Penance

The following are suggested as ways of fulfilling Friday penance:

- Abstaining from meat or some other food;
- Abstaining from alcoholic drink or smoking;
- Making a special effort at involvement in family prayer;
- Making a special effort to participate in Mass;
- Visiting the Blessed Sacrament
- Making the Stations of the Cross;
- Fasting from all food for a longer period than usual and perhaps giving what is saved to the needy;
- Helping the poor, sick, old or lonely.

Care in the Desert

Lent is a time to learn to travel light, to clear the clutter from our crowded lives and find a space, a desert. Deserts are bleak; no creature comforts, only a vast expanse of stillness, sharpening awareness of ourselves and God.
