St Elizabeth Convent

Sisters from St Elizabeth Convent, Belarus will visit our parish on Wednesday 15th March for 10.00am Mass in Tullyallen. St Elizabeth Convent was founded in 1999 in the outskirts of Minsk. Since its establishment it has been patronizing 200 orphanage children with psychophysical deficiencies. There is also a charity shelter on the farmstead of the convent for the homeless, drug and alcohol addicts, ex-prisoners and the less able. To support these ministries, a number of workshops have been set up within the framework of the convent. The sisters will create a small stall selling arts and crafts made in the workshops before and after Mass on 15th March. All support would be greatly appreciated.
