As part of the celebrations for the 150th anniversary of the Dedication of St Patrick's Cathedral, an invitation is extended to all Mothers and Grandmothers in the Archdiocese of Armagh on Thursday 25th May at 7.00pm for Evening Prayer followed by a presentation on the history of St Patrick's Cathedral (not live streamed). First Class Relic of Blessed Carlo Acutis

The relic of Blessed Carlo Acutis will visit St Patrick's Cathedral Armagh from Sunday 11th June until the morning of Tuesday 13th June. Blessed Carlo was beatified by Pope Francis in Assisi on 10th October 2020. He died in 2006, at only 15 years of age, after a battle with leukaemia. Carlo loved football, video games and had a sweet tooth, especially for Italian ice cream! He was an amateur website builder and was most known for recording Eucharistic miracles from across the world on a website he built. He was known for his positive attitude, giftedness with computers and intense devotion to the Eucharist. Young people today can look up to him as a role model and source of inspiration.
