Pause for Hope

The Catholic Cathedral of St Patrick's, Armagh will host an ecumenical prayer service on **Sunday 15th October at 3.30pm** for all those whose lives have been touched by cancer. The service is being organised by the UK based charity *Pause for Hope*. The aim of *Pause for Hope* is to help people affected by cancer through bringing them together in prayer; those who have, or have had cancer, their loved ones, doctors, nurses and carers, those who have responsibility for providing resources, and scientists trying to find a cure. Bishop Michael Router will lead the service. During the service a person affected by cancer will speak about their experience. The musical accompaniment will be provided by organist Colm Murphy and the Cathedral Choir. Light refreshments will be provided in the Synod Hall afterwards, along with an opportunity to share stories and experiences with others in a similar situation. Everyone is welcome to attend.
