Northway Mushroom Factory

The community of Cabragh/Killeeshil needs your help! Currently we have a very serious potential health and environmental hazard coming from a very strong odour emanating from the Northway Mushroom Composting factory on the Aughnagar Road. Our churches, school, Community Centre, football pitch and local shop are all badly affected by this terrible odour on a daily basis. Cabragh Concerned Residents Committee (CCRA) are trying to get help from NI Environment Agency, the Public Health Agency and Mid Ulster Council. These agencies are asking for evidence of the effect of this problem and that can only come from complaints from you, residents and visitors to this community. An online petition has been set up on change.org and petitions are also available to sign in Mc Bride's Spar shop Cabragh, at the football pitch and several other places in the locality.
