#### World Day of Prayer for the Sick

Next Sunday, 11th February is the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes and it is also World Day of Prayer for the Sick. This year's theme is "It is not good that man should be alone." Healing the Sick by Healing Relationships.

In his message for World Day of the Sick, Pope Francis tells us "Brothers and sisters, the first form of care needed in any illness is compassionate and loving closeness. To care for the sick thus means above all to care for their relationships, all of them: with God, with others - family members, friends, healthcare workers - with creation and with themselves. The sick, the vulnerable and the poor are at the heart of the Church; they must also be at the heart of our human concern and pastoral attention."

#### Ash Wednesday - 14th February

Ash Wednesday is a Day of Fast and Abstinence. Mass will be celebrated in Tullyallen at 10.00am and in Ackinduff at 7.30pm. Ashes will be distributed at both Masses.

#### **Stations of the Cross**

There will be Stations of the Cross every Sunday evening during Lent at 7.00pm in Tullyallen, commencing on Sunday 18th February.

#### Friday Penance

The following are suggested as ways of fulfilling Friday penance during Lent:

- Abstaining from meat or some other food;
- Abstaining from alcoholic drink or smoking;
- Making a special effort with family prayer;
- Making a special effort to participate in Mass;
- Visiting the Blessed Sacrament;
- Making the Stations of the Cross;
- Fasting from all food for a longer period than usual and
