
Killeeshil Parish Pastoral Council aims to meet the pastoral needs of the people of the Parish through fostering a more active involvement in living out Christ's mission.

Then there will be an opportunity to meet over 20 apostolates from around Ireland from 11.30 am in St John's Centre.
