St Patrick's Missionary Society

We welcome Fr Brendan Payne from St Patrick's Missionary Society, Kiltegan to our Parish this weekend. St Patrick's Missionary Society, better known as the Kiltegan Fathers, was founded on St Patrick's Day 1932 by Fr Patrick Whitney, a priest of the diocese of Ardagh and Clonmacnois. Since then the Kiltegan Fathers, together with Volunteer Priests and Lay People from different Irish Dioceses, including Armagh, have worked firstly in Nigeria, and later in Kenya, Brazil, Grenada, Malawi, Zambia, South Sudan, Cameroon, Zimbabwe and South Africa. Today there are 210 Kiltegan Fathers, of whom 55 are African, and 90 seminarians preparing for the priesthood.

On the weekend of 15th/16th June two seminarians from the Redemptoris Mater Seminary, Dundalk will come to our parish. They will spend two weeks with us on pastoral placement.
