The Jubilee Logo

The official Logo of this Jubilee year shows four stylised figures, representing all of humanity, from the four corners of the earth. They embrace each other to indicate the solidarity and fraternity which should unite all peoples. The figure at the front is holding onto the cross. It is not only the sign of faith which this lead figure embraces, but also of hope, because we are always in need of hope. There are rough waves under the figures, symbolising the fact that life's pilgrimage does not always go smoothly. The lower part of the cross is elongated and turned into the shape of an anchor which is let down into the waves. The anchor is well known as a symbol of hope. It is worth noting that the image illustrates the pilgrim's journey not as an individual undertaking, but rather as something communal. The cross in the logo bends down towards humanity, stretching out to offer the certainty of its presence and the security of hope.
